

Bachelor of Science in Tourism: Preparation for the Program

Preparatory Training

Students of the Bachelor program in Tourism usually have a diploma of secondary education fulfilling university admission requirements in the country where their secondary education was completed (e.g. Swiss (Berufs-) Matura, German Abitur, French Baccalaureate, British A-Levels, US High School Diploma, Russian Certificate of Secondary Complete General Education, etc.). The majority of modules during the first year of studies can be attended without specific previous knowledge.

Two modules are an exception (depending on the diploma of secondary education): Finance and Accounting and Mathematics.

The prerequisite for the module Finance and Accounting is a basic knowledge of Double-Entry Bookkeeping.

The prerequisite for the module Mathematics is a basic knowledge of terms, equations and functions.
